

Marriage License Applications

Guidelines

- 1. It can take up to two (2) business days to complete an application for a marriage license in the Town of Woodstock.
- 2. Non-residents of Vermont are encouraged to apply for marriage licenses in the town where the wedding will take place.
- 3. The Woodstock Town Clerk's office requires both applicants for the marriage license be present.
- 4. If a passport is submitted as identification, no other form will be required. If applicants do not have passports, another form of government issued photo identification is required along with a certified copy birth certificate.
- 5. If either applicant has been married before, a document indicating the date that the previous marriage ended must be submitted.
