[] Placement of all signs:

- Signs shall be placed on property side of sidewalks. § 517 (A)(5),(6)
- Freestanding signs shall be located between 3 and 10 ft. above ground level. § 517 (B)(2)
- <u>Projecting</u> signs shall not be less than 9 ft. or more than 20 ft. above ground level and shall not project more than 3 ft over a sidewalk.<u>§ 517 (B)(2)</u>

[] Illumination: § 517 (A)(7),(9),(12); Sec. 517(E)

- No illumination after 11:00 p.m. (except hotels, motels, B&B, restaurants, gas stations and emergency services)
- Illumination must be shielded and focused on the sign only to protect night sky and traffic.
- Internally illuminated signs are allowed only for service stations and emergency services not in the Village Design Review area. Only the letter cutouts shall be illuminated, illumination by fluorescent tube and it shall not be excessively bright. Service station signs shall be turned off at closing. Any proposed illumination within a Design Review district is subject to the Design Review process.

Signs requiring no permit

One 12 sq. ft. contractor's sign during construction, one 1 sq. ft "open/closed" sign, one 12 sq. ft. "open " banner for commercial establishments, one 4 sq. ft. real estate "for sale" sign.
