



## **Marriage License Applications**

### **Guidelines**

1. It can take up to two (2) business days to complete an application for a marriage license in the Town of Woodstock.
2. Non-residents of Vermont are encouraged to apply for marriage licenses in the town where the wedding will take place.
3. The Woodstock Town Clerk's office requires both applicants for the marriage license be present.
4. If a passport is submitted as identification, no other form will be required. If applicants do not have passports, another form of government issued photo identification is required along with a certified copy birth certificate.
5. If either applicant has been married before, a document indicating the date that the previous marriage ended must be submitted.
