

**Village of Woodstock, Vermont**  
**Title 8**  
**Woodstock Village Ordinances**  
**2017**

**Added August 8, 2017**  
**Effective October 8, 2017**

The Board of Village Trustees rescinded the existing Title VIII, titled Traffic Vehicles and Parking, and adopted a new Title VIII Woodstock Village Ordinances (W.V.O.) titled Traffic, Vehicles and Parking.

The provisions in the new ordinance that differ from the existing ordinance are as follows:

Summary of Changes

W.V.O. §8237 is amended to allow school buses on School Street when the road is closed to other motor vehicles between September 1st and June 20th annually.

W.V.O. §8222 (e) is added to create temporary parking regulations on Central Street east of the crosswalk between the Woodstock Pharmacy and Bentley's Restaurant and the Post Office Bridge, during bridge construction in 2018.

W.V.O. §8336 entitled Immobilization and Impoundment of Motor Vehicles, is adopted to create to allow the Woodstock Police Department personnel to immobilize a motor vehicle with a device such as a 'Denver Boot', to secure payment of outstanding parking tickets. A vehicle would be subject to immobilization when five (5) or more parking tickets remain unpaid for a single vehicle and the owner has received a minimum of fifteen days' notice of impending immobilization.

Appendix A is amended to expand the no parking zone on the south side of Church Street to include the space between the Episcopal Church and College Hill.

Parking Resolution # 3 is added to create two (2) Electric Vehicle Parking Spaces at the Pleasant Street Park & Ride. These spaces will be regulated with parking meters.

Right to Petition

Citizens of the Village of Woodstock have the right to petition the Board of Village Trustees to reconsider the adoption of this ordinance at a Special Village Meeting provided that such petition is presented to either the Village Trustees or the Village Clerk, no later than September 22, 2017.
