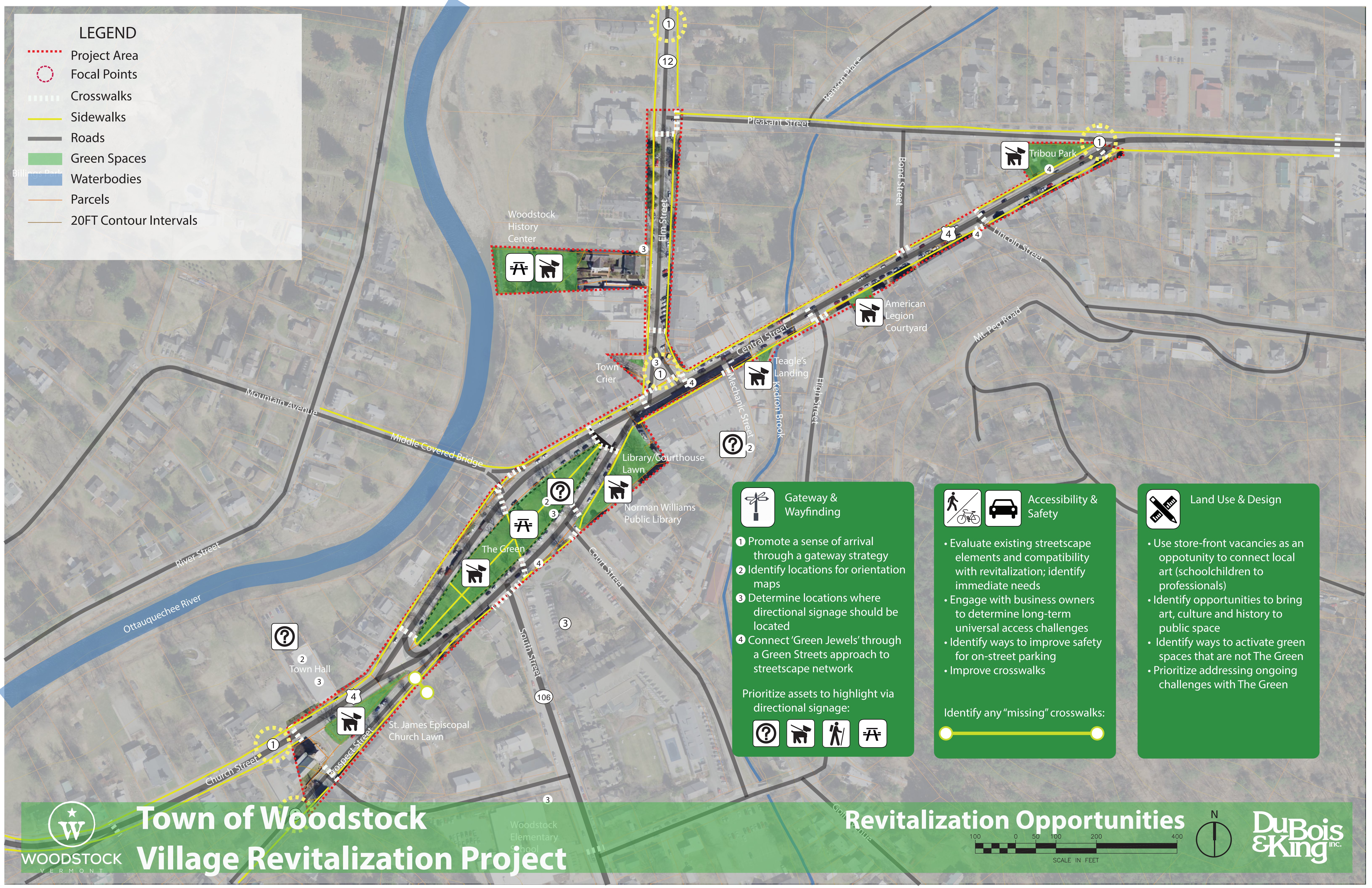



Gateway & Wayfinding

- 1 Promote a sense of arrival through a gateway strategy
- 2 Identify locations for orientation maps
- 3 Determine locations where directional signage should be located
- 4 Connect 'Green Jewels' through a Green Streets approach to streetscape network

Accessibility & Safety

- Evaluate existing streetscape elements and compatibility with revitalization; identify immediate needs
- Engage with business owners to determine long-term universal access challenges
- Identify ways to improve safety for on-street parking
- Improve crosswalks

Land Use & Design

- Use store-front vacancies as an opportunity to connect local art (schoolchildren to professionals)
- Identify opportunities to bring art, culture and history to public space
- Identify ways to activate green spaces that are not The Green
- Prioritize addressing ongoing challenges with The Green

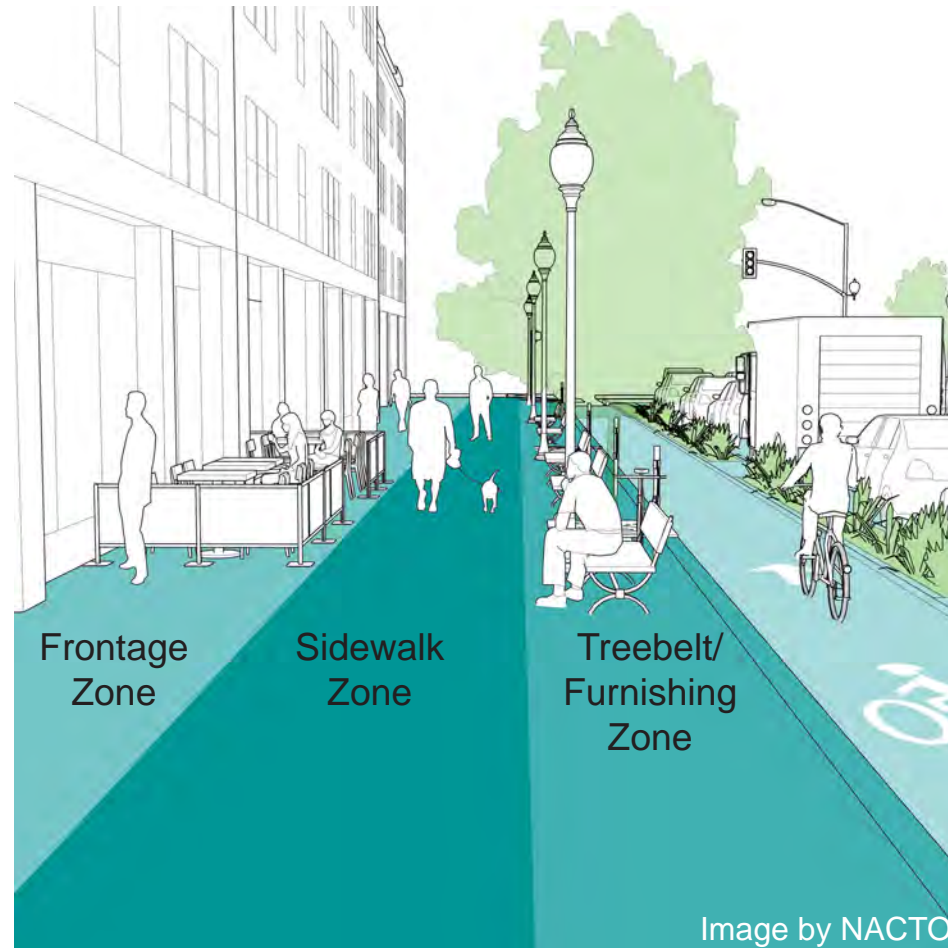

Part of revitalizing Woodstock includes selecting materials and furnishings that guide the design of the streetscape. By providing guidance on furnishings in public spaces, Woodstock is contributing to improving the overall aesthetic by emphasizing high quality, lasting design and materials that connect and improve the public right-of-way for all users. Emphasis is on placing these key amenities in the furnishing zone and not obstructing travel in the sidewalk zone. Alternatives provide flexibility but continuity.

- Polished stainless steel finish
- Must be embedded

Noteworthy:

- Capacity for 3 bikes if accessed both ways; 2 if only one way
- Meets Association of Pedestrian and Bicycle Professionals (APBP) recommendations
- Stainless steel tubing with satin finish on bare stainless steel, also available in powdercoated steel
- May be surface mounted or embedded
