Invitation to Bid Prosper Rd Paving, gravel and ditch work 2019

Project:

The Town of Woodstock is soliciting proposals from qualified firms for a project on Prosper Road. The project involves repaving both ends of the road, adding 2" of gravel to the existing gravel surface, and ditch work as specified.

Mandatory Site Visit

There will be a mandatory site visit on **Friday, May 3rd, 2019 at 10:30am** at the Woodstock Town Hall, 31 The Green, 2nd Floor Conference Room. Meet at Town Hall and then we will travel to the site to review the project.

Scope of Work:

Paving:

- Resurface, according to VTrans specifications, the paved sections on both ends of Prosper Rd. With a 1" shim and a 2" overlay.
- Paint a double yellow line
- Paint stop bars on intersections with VT 12 and US 4

Gravel surface:

- Add a 3" layer of hard pack, must have lots of stone, not dust.
- Grade and incorporate new hard pack with existing road surface
- Spray with Calcium Chloride
- Compact with a vibratory roller.

Ditch work:

- Ditches are to be created as specified on a map to be distributed at the site visit.
- Ditch profile should be 2 foot horizontal to 1 foot vertical where feasible.
- All ditches between 0% slope and 5% slope to be treated with grass seed such as conservation mix and fertilizer.
 - Seed, fertilizer, and sprayed mulch hay is satisfactory
- All ditches that exceed 5% and are less than 10% slope to be treated according to current VTrans standards with stone lining using 6 to 8 minus rip rap.
- All ditches greater than 10% slope to be treated with 12" minus stone.

NOTE: The stone in the ditch to be set 6" below the grade of the road.



Bids:

Bids are due on **Wednesday, May 15th** at Town Offices at 10:00AM.

Bids will be opened publicly in the Municipal Manager's Office at the Woodstock Town Hall located at 31 The Green.
