## **Invitation to Bid Engineering Services Covered Bridge Repairs Lincoln Covered Bridge 2019**

Request for Proposal & Request for Qualifications

### **Project:**

The Town of Woodstock is soliciting proposals for engineering services for the design of significant structural repairs to the Lincoln Covered Bridge that was damaged in a motor vehicle accident on May 15, 2019.

### **Proposal Should Include:**

- Acknowledgment that the firm is pre-qualified by VTrans to design covered bridges and conduct restoration of such bridges.
- References from other towns for covered bridge work.
- Covered bridge design work for the Lincoln Covered Bridge.
- Assistance with bidding and bid analysis
- Inspection of the covered bridge and a final certification that the repairs match the design.
- The end result of the project is to have the covered bridge restored to pre-accident condition.
