Proposed Development: To construct a 26' x 21' addition with first floor garage and second floor office, remove and replace two existing windows.

Ben Nickerson explained that the existing house needs a garage, and the owner would also like a space above the garage for a home office. The proposed garage will be built into the side of the hill. The driveway is shared via easement with the neighbor. Randy Mayhew asked if cars will need to back onto South Street or change curb cuts and they said no, traffic patterns will stay the same.

Randy Mayhew asked about the placement of windows recommended by the Design Advisory Committee. Ben Nickerson presented the revised elevation showing the windows now spaced similar to existing house and the rectangular window on south end of home. Keri Cole inquired about exterior lighting and Ben said lighting will be added to the garage but will be downlight and no glare. Garage doors will not have windows.
